Other ways for you to connect with a college include:

-Check schools' websites. Yes, look at the Admissions pages, but also look at pages relating to student activities, majors offered, academic departments and programming and more

-Call or email admission reps directly

-Use the Chat Bot on the schools' website

-Complete surveys that the schools send you so they can focus the future info they send

-Utilize Social Media: Instagram, Twitter, Facebook
