COMMON APPLICATION (commonapp.org):

The Common Application is accepted by over 900 colleges, and it is likely that the vast majority of our students will use it for at least some of their schools. While students are free to open up their Common App account, it is still currently this year's version. The 2021-22 Common Application will launch on August 1, 2021. Information already entered into the application will roll over into the current version.

LOOKING FOR COLLEGES THAT ARE A GOOD FIT?

Have you checked out Naviance, our college search engine yet? While on there, try the SuperMatch College Search (found on the Colleges tab) to find colleges that may be a good fit for you. This search tool collects information from you about what you want in a college and lets you rank your requirements to help you find schools that may be a match for you. You will get not only a list of schools that suit your needs perfectly, but you'll also see other schools that come close. Other great resources are Big Future found at bigfuture.collegeboard.org and collegeweeklive.com as well as many other sites listed under the College Planning link on the Guidance home page.
