Students must ask teachers for these letters in person or by email, and should then request their teachers on Naviance. (Link is on the Colleges I'm Applying To page, towards the bottom.) If you are unsure what to say, take a look at the sample emails we put for you in the Google Classroom to help you get started.

### **RESUME:**

Don't have a resume yet? Check out Naviance's Resume building link found on the About Me tab, under My Stuff. It's a useful tool to help ensure that all relevant information is included to highlight your activities and accomplishments. Sample resumes were also provided in the Junior College Planning packets located on the Google Classroom.
