

JUNIOR JOB SHADOW








WHAT IS JOB SHADOW

* An opportunity for juniors to follow a career professional at their workplace to learn more about a particular occupation or industry.



PURPOSE

- Helps you to explore different career paths and/or majors for college
- Connects what you are learning in school to jobs/careers in the real world

EXPECTATIONS

- Mandatory for all juniors.
- If you don't have a site, you will complete a career exploration curriculum during school.



SITE EXPECTATIONS

Schedule an arrival and departure time with your site mentor at least two weeks ahead of time

- ★ We recommend a full day but 4 hours minimum
- ★ You must provide your own transportation
- **X** Discuss your responsibilities and goals as a student
- * Arrive with your own questions
- Research the company online before going in for the day
