


# What is the Senior Internship Program?

# Internship


This requires you to spend 30 hours per week for the last 6 weeks of the school year on site working in your potential future field.

You will work under the supervision of your site mentor and gain hands on experience.


\*This cannot be a paid job that you already have\*


Complete the appropriate application forms on the CHS School to Careers Website (QR Codes will be hung in house offices and Career Center)




Accepted students will be notified early March. Applications needing revisions will be returned & revisions must be returned within 3 school days.



You will be assigned a house based faculty advisor to support/monitor your internship experience. Attend Orientation and Advisor meetings.




#### Do I Qualify for the Internship?



(Subtract 5 hours per week from required 30 hours per AP/ DE course)

#### Advanced Placement and

Dual Enrollment Courses



Remain in scheduled block until the AP exam and earn a grade for fourth quarter.

After you take the AP exam, you are finished with that course.


If you are not taking the exam, you will be done at the end of term 3.



If you are enrolled in a Semester 2

Dual Enrollment course you need to be present for that class during the internship throughout the 4th quarter.



### Senior Final Grades

Final grades for full year courses will be the average of the first three terms.

Senior internship will be assessed on a Pass/Fail basis by the student's Faculty Advisor based on the provided rubric.
