The Tsongas Center parking lots are available for all events held at the Tsongas Center. Located right next to the venue the parking lots at the Tsongas Center are perfect place to park leaving you steps from the ceremony

Parking is sold in advance through our partner ParkMobile. Purchase using this LINK. Any remaining inventory will be sold on the day of the event in the parking lot.

There are numerous parking garages surrounding the Tsongas Center at UMass Lowell.

- George Ayotte Garage: Located next to the Tsongas Center Parking Lot B.
- Joseph Downes Garage: Quick .4 mile 8 minute walk to the Tsongas Center.
- Leo A. Roy Garage: Located Downtown Lowell and is a short 11 minute .5 mile walk.

Directions

Please plan your visit to the Tsongas Center in advance. Travel to the venue may take longer than expected due to high volume traffic. Guest should plan to arrive an hour prior to ceremony. If using a GPS on your smart phone use the address 300 Martin Luther King Jr. Way, Lowell, MA 01852.

Security Checks & Tickets

For the safety and security of our guests and staff, Tsongas Center at UMass Lowell employs the use of walkthrough metal detectors for all events taking place at the venue. Patrons who require alternative screening options due to medical or accessibility reasons may request this upon arrival at the venue. Guests that refuse to submit to either a walkthrough, wand or pat-down search shall be refused entry.

Tsongas Center Bag Policy:

In order to maintain a safe and secure environment at the Tsongas Center we have implemented a new bag policy that limits the size and type of bags that may be brought into our venue.

Guests will be able to carry ONE of the following bags into the Tsongas Center:

- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag(Ziploc bag or similar).
- One bag that is clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and does not exceed 12" x 12" x 6".
- Small clutch bags, which CANNOT exceed 6.5" x 4.5" in size, with or without a handle or strap.
- All bags within clear plastic bags cannot exceed 6.5" x 4.5" in size.

Please contact the graduates High School directly for ticketing information. Tickets will not be sold or distributed at the Tsongas Center Box office.

Seating is on a first come first serve bases unless in premium seating and/or a suite. Guest interested in sitting together should arrive together.

Information for Individuals with Disabilities

Accessible seating is located throughout the arena with locations dependent upon the type of event and location of the stage. Guests who need accessible seating, for the ceremony and did not receive tickets in an accessible area will be accommodated to the best of our ability.

The Tsongas Center offers one public elevator and is accessible from either the East Entrance or the Main Entrance of the Tsongas Center.

Tsongas Center Frequently Asked Questions



What time do doors open for each ceremony? Doors open one hour (60 minutes) before each ceremony.



What is the Tsongas Centers bag policy? Guests will be able to carry ONE of the following bags into the Tsongas Center:

- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag(Ziploc bag or similar).
- One bag that is clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and does not exceed 12" x 12" x 6".
- Small clutch bags, which CANNOT exceed 6.5" x 4.5" in size, with or without a handle or strap.

The general rule in regards to camera is that non-professional cameras are allowed.




